On 5/28/2020, Paul Mitchell the School Fresno signed and returned to the Department the Certification and Agreement and the assurance that the institution has used, or intends to use, no less than 50 percent of the funds received under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students.
2. Paul Mitchell the School Fresno received \$275,123 from the Department pursuant to the institution's Certification and Agreement for Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students.
3. Paul Mitchell the School Fresno distributed the following amount of Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act;
 - On 6/12/2020, \$137,561 was distributed to approximately 234 students as Emergency Financial Aid Grants under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act.

Emergency Relief Fund Reporting the Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students

Paul Mitchell the School Fresno received a disbursement of \$1,375,123 from the U.S. Department of Education. The funds must be used to cover expenses related to the disruption of campus operations of higher education schools and students due to the disruption of campus operations from coronavirus.

- On 5/28/2020 Paul Mitchell the School Fresno signed and returned to the Department of Education the Certification and Agreement and the assurances that the institution has added, or intends to add, to its Student Emergency Disbursement Funds. The following are the terms of this grant:
 - Disbursement 2 (do not include graduates whose graduation date was prior to the date of disbursement) or could be eligible to participate in programs under Section 484 in Title IV of the Higher Education Act of 1965, as amended (HEA),
 - Paul Mitchell the School Fresno received \$275,123 from the Department pursuant to the institution's Certification and Agreement for Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students. Total Amount of Disbursement: \$137,561. Eligibility to participate in programs under Section 484 the HEA. Students who have not filed a FAFSA but who are eligible to file a FAFSA also may receive Disbursement Amount Per Student: \$587.87
 - Paul Mitchell the School Fresno did not follow the following Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act:
 - Each student will need to sign the Student Agreement for CARES Act document to acknowledge completion of high school in an approved home school setting.
 - The accounting of the funds will be tracked by the school and reported to the U.S. Department of Education.
 - a. Students who took a "Leave of Absence" on or after March 13, 2020 are eligible, if the reason for the leave of absence was related to COVID-19. The school must document the specific reason for the leave of absence to show that it was COVID-19 related.
 - % On 7/16/2020, \$137,561 was distributed to approximately 234 students as Emergency Financial Aid Grants under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act.
 - b. Students who started in a Title IV eligible program after March 13, 2020 Erik Pedersen are eligible.
- 234 students have received an Emergency Financial Aid Grant of \$587.87 under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act.
 - Must have a graduation date after March 13, 2020.
 - Students who start school after June 1, 2020 or later are not be eligible for the funds.
- Please see attached, Policy on distribution of CARES Grant funds to students and Student Agreement for the CARES Act.

The school will distribute the funds in 2 different separate disbursements thirty days apart and will divide the funds available equally among the students who meet the criteria listed above based on the date of disbursement. If the student does not cash the check within 90 days, the funds will then be disbursed to other eligible students.
