Certification and Agreement for CRRSAA Funds

Total Funds Received

Paul Mitchell The School Denver has received \$173,136 in total funds pursuant to the institution's Certification and Agreement for Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students on March 8, 2021.

Eligible Students

Number of Grants Awarded

Amount of Grants Awarded

The total amount of Emergency Financial Aid Grants awarded to students under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CRRSAA Act as of January 10, 2022 is \$173,136. The amount of funds that have been disbursed to students is \$173,136.

Application & Awarding Process

Qualifying Students

Disbursement 1: All currently enrolled students are eligible as of March 8, 2021 and must be an active student on day of disbursement.

Disbursement2: All currently enrolled students are eligible as of October 20, 2021 and must be an active student on day of disbursement.

Award Methodology

To support equitable opportunity for the student body to receive relief funds and prioritize those with higher need, awards were granted as follows:

\$110,903.69 grant available to Pell eligible students with a qualifying need \$62,232.31 grant available to non-Pell eligible students with a qualifying need

Disbursement

Grants were delivered to student via paper check or posted to student account at students request after receipt of student's acknowledgement and written consent.

Communication
