The Opportunity Scholarship is offered to students who are first-generation students. A first-generation student is defined as a student whose parents have no more than two years of education beyond high school and no post-secondary degree.

Scholarship Criteria:

- The FASFA must indicate that neither parent's education level is above high school.
- Students are eligible for a one-time maximum award of \$500.
- Students will be eligible to receive the non-cash award in two scholarship credits of \$250 at the end of each applicable payment period.
- Students must maintain satisfactory academic progress at the end of each applicable payment period to remain eligible.
