

# **HEERF III - American Recovery Act (ARA) Student Grants Report**

## **Certification and Agreement for HEERF III- American Recovery Act (ARA) Funds**

**Paul Mitchell the School Spokane** acknowledges that they have signed and returned the official Certification and Agreement for CARES Act funds to the US Department of Education on **8/6/2021** – which serves as formal acknowledgment and acceptance of subsequently awarded American Recovery Act (ARA) funds under Section 2003(a) (1).

## **Total Funds Received**

**Paul Mitchell the School Spokane** has received **\$238,734.00** in total funds pursuant to the institution's Certification and Agreement for Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students on **8/6/2021**.

## **Eligible Students**

The estimated total number of students at **Paul Mitchell the School Spokane** eligible to receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students under Section 2003(a) (1) of the ARA Grant is 93.

## **Number of Grants Awarded**

**Paul Mitchell the School Spokane** has awarded **55** students grants under Section 2003(a) (1) of the ARA Grant.

## **Amount of Grants Awarded**

The total amount of Emergency Financial Aid Grants awarded to students under Section S2003(a) (1) of the ARA Act as of October 10, 2021 is **\$238,734.00** The amount of funds that have been disbursed to students is **\$217,835.46**.

## **Application & Awarding Process**

### **Qualifying Students**

All currently enrolled students are eligible as of 8/6/2021 and must be an active student on day of disbursement.

### **Outreach Method**

Email, with link to secure online form indicating need was sent to student group identified above.

## **Award Methodology**

To support equitable opportunity for the student body to receive relief funds and prioritize those with higher need, awards were granted as follows:

**\$3272.36** grant available to Pell eligible and/or VA students with a qualifying need

**\$2691.84** grant available to all eligible students with a qualifying need

## **Disbursement**

Grants were mailed to student via paper check or posted to student account at students request after receipt of student's acknowledgement and written consent.

## **Communication**

Information for the grant and the application was communicated via email to all currently enrolled students on **8/6/2021**.
