

Emergency Relief Fund Reporting – Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students

Information as of June 19, 2020

1. On May 7, 2020, Paul Mitchell The School Birmingham signed and returned to the Department the Certification and Agreement and the assurance that the institution has used, or intends to use, no less than 50 percent of the funds received under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students.
2. Paul Mitchell The School Birmingham received \$135,706 from the Department pursuant to the institution's Certification and Agreement [for] Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Student.
3. Paul Mitchell The School Birmingham plans to distribute \$135,706 of Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act within the next 30 days. The number of students set to receive a portion of the grant is still to be determined.
