

## **HEERF II- CRRSAA Student Grants Report**

**Information as of October 1, 2021**

### **Certification and Agreement for CRRSAA Funds**

Paul Mitchell The School Costa Mesa (additional campuses in San Diego, CA, Cranston, RI, Sterling Heights, MI, Orlando & Tampa, FL) acknowledges that they have signed and returned the official Certification and Agreement for CARES Act funds to the US Department of Education on February 15, 2021 – which serves as formal acknowledgment and acceptance of subsequently awarded Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act (CRRSAA) funds.

### **Total Funds Received**

Paul Mitchell The School Costa Mesa has received \$1,401,020 in total funds pursuant to the institution's Certification and Agreement for Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students on 3/1/2021.

### **Eligible Students**

The estimated total number of students at Paul Mitchell The School Costa Mesa eligible to receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students under Section 18004(a)(1) of CRRSAA is 644 as of 10/1/2021.

### **Number of Grants Awarded**

Paul Mitchell The School Costa Mesa has awarded 643 students grants under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CRRSAA.

### **Amount of Grants Awarded**

The total amount of Emergency Financial Aid Grants awarded to students under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CRRSAA Act as of October 10, 2021 is \$686,743.35 The amount of funds that have been disbursed to students is \$686,743.35.

### **Application & Awarding Process**

#### **Qualifying Students**

All currently enrolled students are eligible as of October 8, 2021 and must be an active student on day of disbursement.

**Outreach Method**

Email, with link to secure online form indicating need was sent to student group identified above.

**Award Methodology**

To support equitable opportunity for the student body to receive relief funds and prioritize those with higher need, awards were granted as follows:

\$1258.30 grant available to Pell eligible students with a qualifying need

\$1258.30 grant available to non-Pell eligible students with a qualifying need

\$838.87 grant available to non-Pell eligible students without a qualifying need

**Disbursement**

Grants were delivered to student via paper check or posted to student account at students request after receipt of student's acknowledgement and written consent.

**Communication**

Information for the next portion of the grant and the application will be communicated to all currently enrolled students in early October 2021.
