Certification and Agreement for HEERF III- American Recovery Act (ARA) Funds

Total Funds Received

PMTS Richland has received **\$98,907.50** in total funds pursuant to the institution's Certification and Agreement for Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students on **9/14/2021**.

Award Methodology

To support equitable opportunity for the student body to receive relief funds awards were granted as follows:
