#### **ELIGIBILITY**

- Applicants must be accepted by another school that offers a similar course of study at the time of awarding or disbursement.
- Each applicant may receive only ONE Paul Mitchell Schools' scholarship award per education program.
- The applicant must be a U.S. citizen, at least seventeen (17) years old, with a high school diploma or equivalent, or upcoming high school graduation prior to the chosen enrollment date.
- Scholarship recipients must maintain grades of 90% in theory, 90% in practical, and 90% attendance throughout each Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) period, and maintain full compliance with Paul Mitchell Schools' rules and regulations.
- **6** Employees of the school and their family members are NOT eligible to participate.

## **SCHOLARSHIP DETAILS**

- All applications will be reviewed by and all decisions made by the committee will be final.
- e scholarships in the amount of will be available for the lf no eligible applications are submitted, the scholarship will be void.
- 3 Scholarship awards will be indicated as a credit in the recipient's tuition ledger. The award will be disbursed in one installment upon completion of his/her program hours. The scholarship recipient must maintain 90% satisfactory scores for theory, practical, and attendance, and maintain full compliance with Paul Mitchell Schools' rules and regulations. Recipients will forfeit their scholarships if they fail to complete the program or achieve the eligibility requirements, which will be reviewed with recipients during each SAP review period.
- Scholarships may be applied to tuition. Scholarship funds may not be applied to the student kit.

## SCHOLARSHIP ESSAY OR VIDEO ESSAY

- Scholarship Committee will review all submitted scholarship essay and video entries. Judging criteria includes content, creativity, as well as the candidate's ability to show drive and enthusiasm for the industry, commitment to their future and a dedication and involvement in giving back to the community. Essays will also be evaluated for syntax, spelling and grammar.
- Scholarship applicants can choose to submit either an essay or video, along with the completed scholarship application.



# **SCHOLARSHIP ESSAY OR VIDEO ESSAY (Continued)**

- Scholarship essays must be typed (double-spaced and single-sided) answering the questions on the application. Include your name and contact information on the essay. Limit your entry to five hundred (500) words.
- Scholarship video essays must be submitted in .mp4 format or as a YouTube link, and must answer all of the questions on the application. Include your name and contact information in the title of your video essay. Limit your entry to five (5) minutes or less.

## LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION

Please submit two (2) letters of recommendation from an employer, supervisor, teacher, or other individual who can speak about your abilities and community involvement. Recommendations may not be written by family members.

#### RECIPIENT SELECTION

- Selection will be based on the applicant's enrollment eligibility, submitted application and related materials.
